Exercise: Printing All Data in a Category

Purpose: To learn about the different ways one can produce lists of data with Habitat Tracker©.

Listing Reports offer a way to see multiple records of the same data category on one report. Instead of displaying all the data entered for each record, these reports display only a few pieces of information for each record, but list multiple records. Listing reports allow us to review and compare the main data values for one, several, or many records on the same report. In addition, sometimes we can print the same listing in different ways by changing how the records are grouped!
