Project: Creating your Habitat Journal

Purpose: To organize all of the data and information you have collected about your habitat in one place. Your Habitat Journal will become a documentary of your habitat.



Materials Needed:

1. A 1 inch, 3 ring, view binder notebook
2. A set of 8 notebook dividers

Project:

1. **Create** a cover for your journal.
2. **Label** the dividers as follows:
 - i. Habitats
 - ii. Plants
 - iii. Wildlife
 - iv. Habitat Observations
 - v. Tasks and Maintenance
 - vi. Resources and Notes
 - vii. Lists and Analysis
 - viii. Projects
3. As you complete all of the Habitat Tracker© exercises and worksheets, **enter** them into the appropriate section in your Habitat Journal.
4. Each time you complete data entry for an entity in Habitat Tracker©, **print** out the '**Profile Report**' and add it to the appropriate section of your Habitat Journal. Place the Profile Report next to the worksheet containing your raw data.
5. As you start to collect groups of data, **print** out **Listing Reports** for that category.
6. After you have observed your habitat for some time, **print** out some of the **Analysis Reports** and see what you might learn from your observations!
7. And, most of all, **Happy Tracking!**
